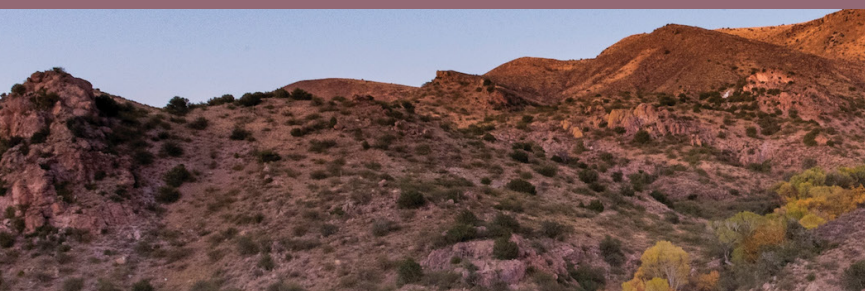

Objective

The project aims to ensure the long-term conservation of nine private ranches certified as Areas Voluntarily Destined for Conservation (ADVC, acronym in Spanish) in northern Sonora through effective administration and management.

Lines of work

1 Efficient administration of the nine CLO properties.

2 Effective administration of the nine CLO properties.

ADVC managed by CLO.



Achievements

Conservation of **50,000 hectares** of native grasslands and shrublands.

Monitoring of 16 sites with the SiPeCaM* tool, using camera traps and audio recordings.

Conservation of the habitat of more than **150 animals species**, including jaguar, ocelot, and black bear.

Data updated at the end of 2023.
